



UC Davis Educational Seminar Funds Application Guidelines

Goal: Increase member knowledge and skills for improving Idaho's wine industry

**Under this opportunity, application for additional education travel funds is not available. Only one award will be presented per individual.*

Selection Process

Applicants will be selected on the basis of previous IWC educational seminar attendance, involvement in IWC and industry endeavors, and demonstration of individual motivation for continued knowledge.

Awardees will be selected by the IWC Education Committee and Board of Commissioners.

Who's Eligible?

Idaho Wine Commission members with a passion for improving their knowledge of viticulture and enology.

Awardee Responsibilities

By applying for and accepting the terms of the agreement, the awardee agrees to collect all necessary receipts for reimbursement upon completion. The IWC's grant funds will support awardees with their airfare, hotel and seminar registration to attend a selected educational seminar at UC Davis. Receipts for ground transportation and meals can be utilized as matching funds and must be submitted as well. A written summary of how the seminar was beneficial to you must be submitted to the IWC prior to receiving expense reimbursement. This information may be condensed and used in the IWC weekly member newsletter.

Award: Up to 10 Idaho Wine Commission members will be selected to attend one of the following UC Davis seminars of their choosing. Seminar dates and availability will be made known as UC Davis makes them available. Please select and rank your top three choices, with 1 being your top choice and 3 being last. (Listed Below)

Guidelines:

The IWC will support awardees attending one selected educational seminar at UC Davis. Seminar registration will be paid for by the IWC upfront, all remaining eligible expenses will be reimbursed to awardee upon return and receipt of written review documents. Receipts for matching funds must also be provided. To be eligible, members must complete and submit a request form by September 30, 2016. The IWC will contact all interest members once registration is open. The first five members to notify and confirm availability will be registered to attend. Funds are available for airfare, registration and hotel costs. The recipient agrees to:

1. Accept funds will be awarded after the final report and receipts have been submitted with the exception of registration.
2. Submit all receipts applicable for travel reimbursement and matching funds.
3. Write a summary of the most pertinent data gained, for inclusion in the weekly email.
